From the Pastor

Dear family in Christ,

It is Lent - Lent is the season to prepare for Easter. We prepare through prayer, acknowledging our sins, repentance, disciplining the flesh, giving alms, and more; we do activities which call us to be mindful of the season. It's important to remind ourselves that this "doing" is not something done to benefit our salvation - Jesus did that for us - but it is useful in keeping us mindful of our calling as Christians. We "spur one another on to love and good works." Heb 10:24

During this Lenten season I invited you to join with me in a visit to the Bible's Arboretum. An arboretum in a general sense is a collection of trees; a botanical garden composed exclusively of woody plants intended at least in part for scientific study. The term arboretum comes from the Latin (arbor = tree, arboretum place grown with trees) and the term was first used in an English publication back in 1833. Each Wednesday we will visit, through our imaginations, an Arboretum filled with trees from the Bible and then explore their story.

On Ash Wednesday we visited the rare and mysterious "tree of the knowledge of good and evil" which is found only in the Garden of Eden. It was instrumental in the fall of humankind and is a powerful reminder that "we are dust and to dust we shall return." In the coming weeks we will see, among others, the trees of Mamre, the Oak at Ophra, Jesse's tree, the fig tree, the tree of the cross, and other trees of the Lord's planting. I think you will find it both educational and inspirational.

Please keep all Christians in your prayers that we might be a good witness to others. Remember especially your sister LCMS congregations in North & West Toledo. We each need a clear vision of the Lord's will for us.

A couple items we would like to take care of this year is a new (used) commercial lawn mower for around \$3,000. We found one and put a down payment of \$500 to hold the lawn mower till spring. Each time we go out to buy groceries or personal items remember those who God wants us to help. Just buy one thing and drop it in the boxes in the narthex. Can we make it a routine? 
